

FRONT UPPER WISHBONE REAR BUSH

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Product description:

This part replaces OE number: RBX500301 and fits into the rear position of the front upper wishbone. These bushes incorporate steel support washers that are designed to spread load across the arm and protect_the bushes from sharp edges found on pressed steel arms fitted to Discovery 3 and 4 vehicles. For cast arms found on Range Rover Sport_(2005-2013) use PFF32-408.

Contents (parts per pack):

- 2 x Polyurethane A bushes
- 2 x Polyurethane B bushes
- 2 x Stainless steel sleeves

1 x Grease

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- all safety precautions adhered to;
- wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.
- All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

Fitting Instructions:

- 1. Remove the original rubber bushes from the rear position of the front upper wishbone, clean any dirt and corrosion from its bore.
- 2. Fit the polyurethane A bush into the rear bush position of the wishbone from the outside face of the wishbone and from the rear of the car.
- Fit the polyurethane B bush into the rear bush position of the wishbone from the inside face of the 3. wishbone and from the front of the car.
- Apply some of the supplied grease to the bore of the bush and insert the sleeve into the bush. 4.
- 5. Re-fit the wishbone to the car and tension all hardware to manufacturers recommended torgue settings.
