FRONT CONTROL ARM TO CHASSIS BUSH

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Contents (parts per pack):

- 4 x Polyurethane Bushes 1 x PTFE/Silicone Grease
- 2 x Stainless Steel Sleeves
- 2 x Zinc Plated Mild Steel Outer Shells

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- -all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- -all safety precautions adhered to;
- -wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.
- -All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

Fitting Instructions:

- 1. Remove the original rubber bush from the front control arm.
- 2. Clean any dirt and corrosion from the bore of the arm and file off any sharp edges.
- 3. Insert the zinc plated mild steel outer shell into the bore of the arm, until the lip of the shell is in contact with the arm.
- 4. Push the polyurethane bushes into the bore of the outer shell so they sit flush inside.
- 5. Apply some of the supplied grease into the bore of the polyurethane bush and insert the stainless steel sleeve into the bush so it sits flush inside.
- 6. Refit the arm back to the vehicle and tension all hardware to manufacturers recommended torque settings.
